Next Dinner Run

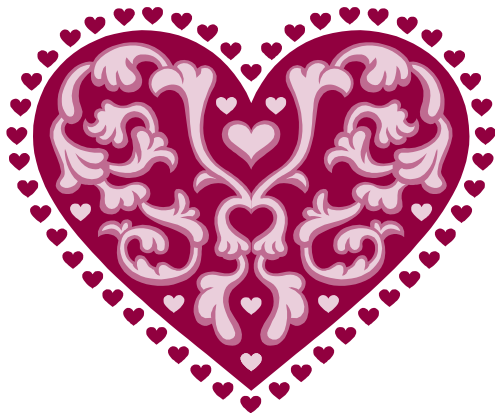
